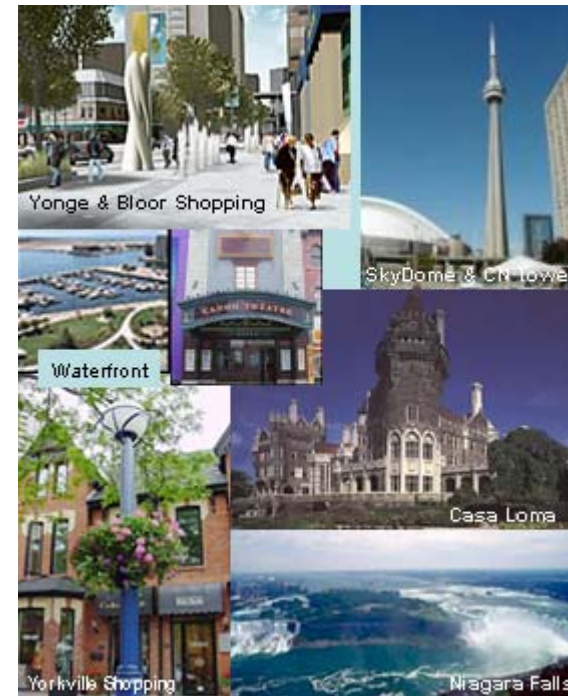

## 13<sup>th</sup> ISRP Conference Overview

The Americas Section welcomes members and others with an interest in respiratory protection to the 13<sup>th</sup> International Conference of the International Society for Respiratory Protection. The Conference will be held in Toronto, Canada on August 27-September 1, 2006. Toronto is Canada's largest city and is the business, financial and cultural centre of the country. It is situated on beautiful Lake Ontario – one of the 7 great lakes in central North America. For visitors, there are many scenic, cultural and entertainment venues – in fact, it is the 3<sup>rd</sup> largest live theatre centre in the world and has over 6,000 restaurants. Attractions include the CN Tower, which pierces the skyline of Toronto like an exclamation mark. On a clear day, the view from the CN Tower's SkyPod can stretch 160 km and bring Niagara Falls and Rochester, NY into sight. Other attractions include the Harbourfront, Toronto Islands and historic Old Town. The city has excellent transportation connections by air, road and rail.

The conference will be held in the Toronto Sheraton Centre Hotel, Toronto. This high quality hotel has a superb location in the heart of the city's theatre and entertainment district, just steps away from the Eaton Centre shopping area. The Sheraton Centre features 2.5 acres of picturesque waterfalls, gardens, and terraces, a fitness centre, pool and spa. A block of rooms has been booked for the conference at a special rate.

## Program & Events

The 13<sup>th</sup> ISRP Conference will focus on a range of topics including Respiratory Protection for Healthcare Workers and Emergency Responders, Respiratory Protection Issues in Developing countries, and Respiratory Protection for Emerging Hazards. The conference program will include plenary presentations, invited lectures on emerging issues, and panel discussions. The conference will also include a reception and banquet. An optional day tour to Niagara Falls will be organized for the weekend ahead of the conference, and additional city tours will be available.
